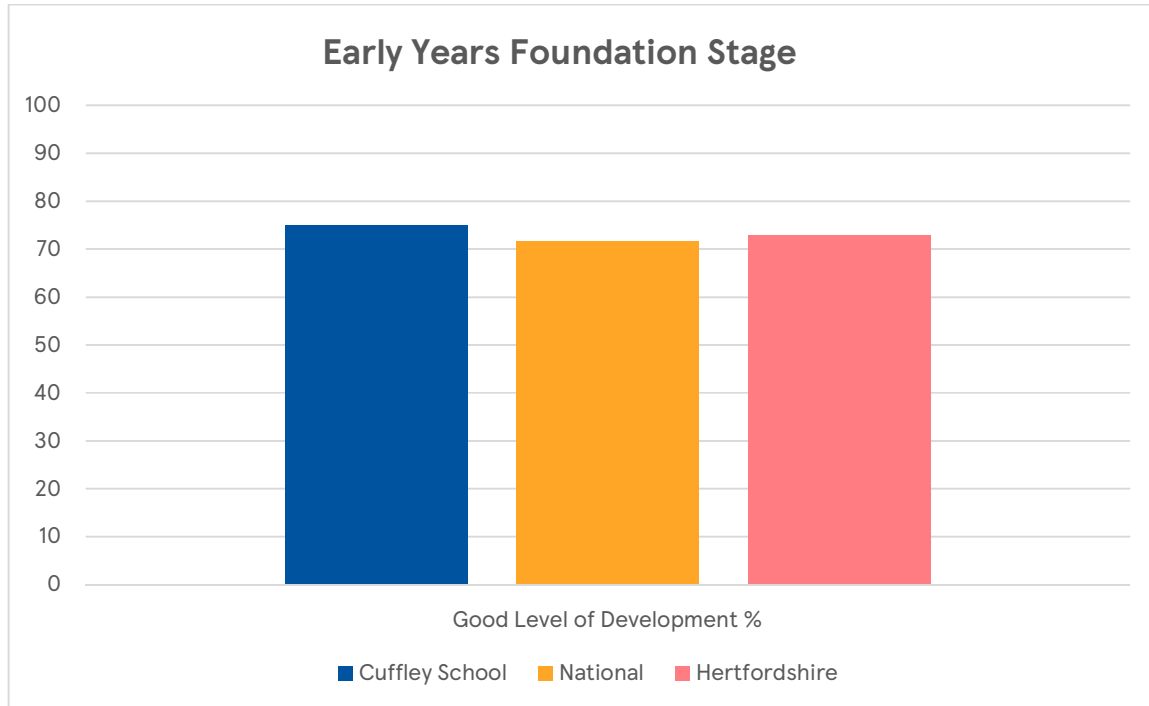
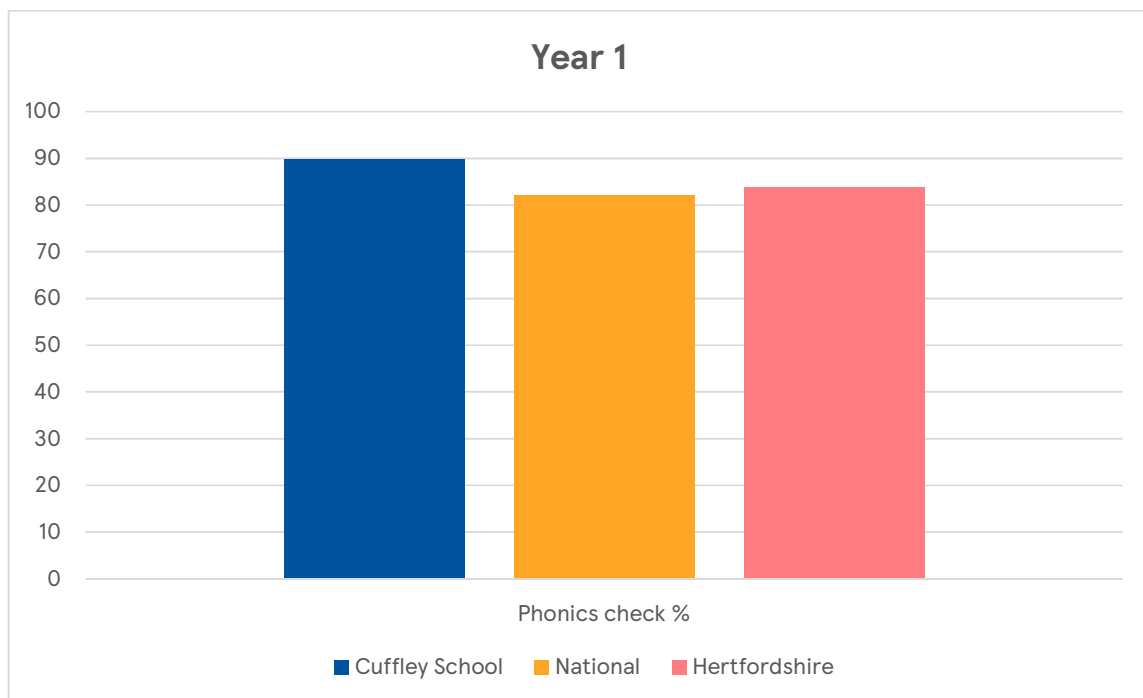


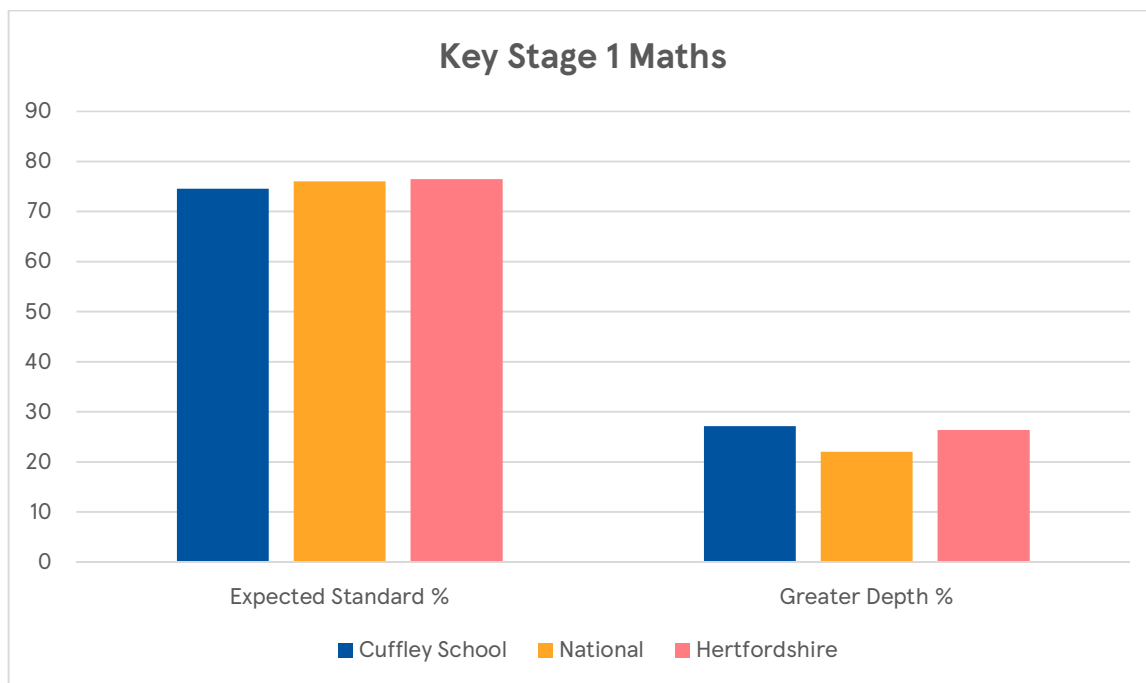
Cuffley School Attainment Overview 2019



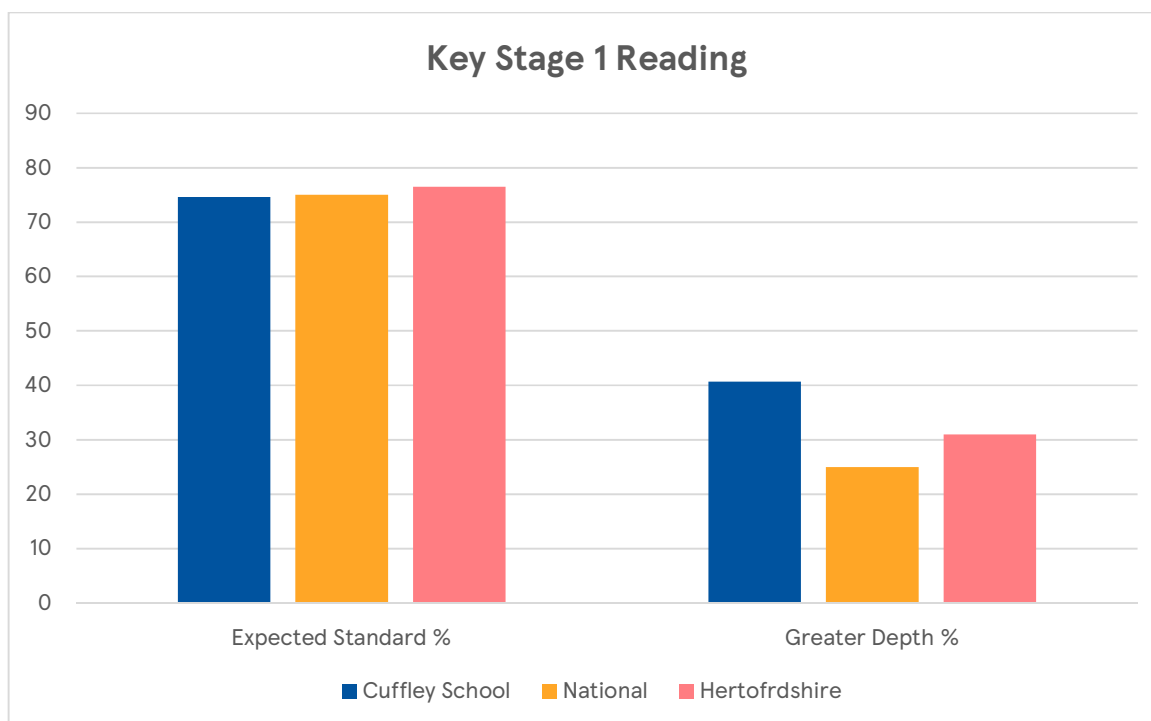
In EYFS, our percentage of children achieving GLD has increased this year and is now slightly above both Hertfordshire and national.



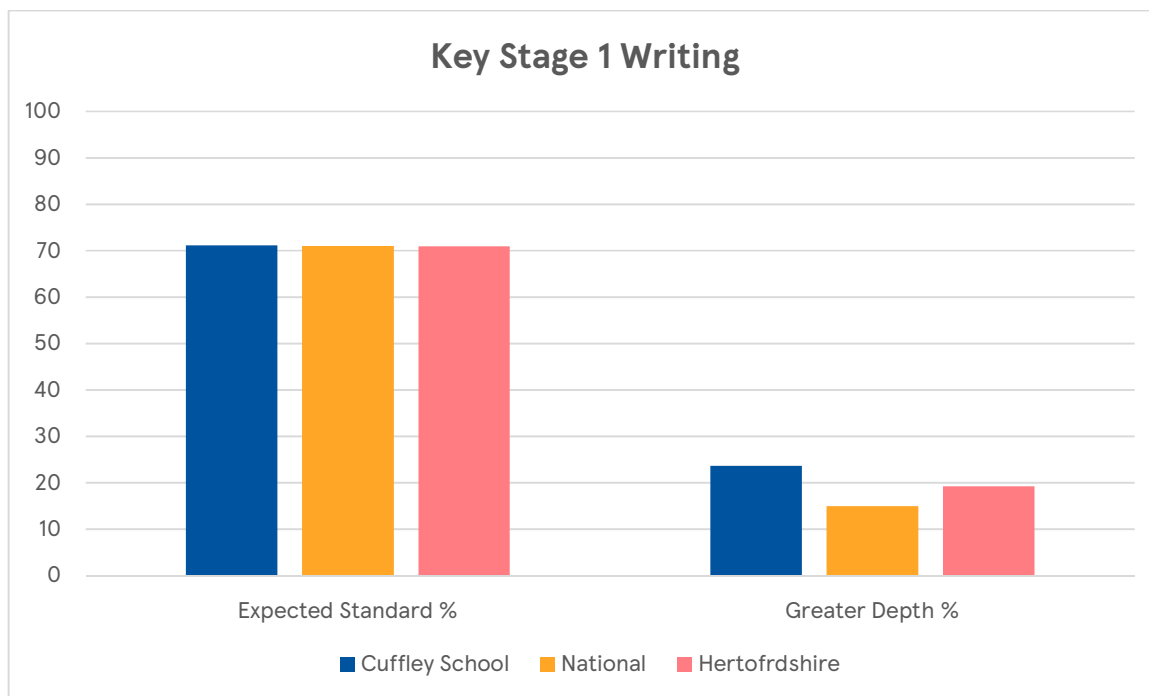
The percentage of children who pass the year 1 phonics check at Cuffley continues to be extremely high and significantly above both the averages for Hertfordshire and national.



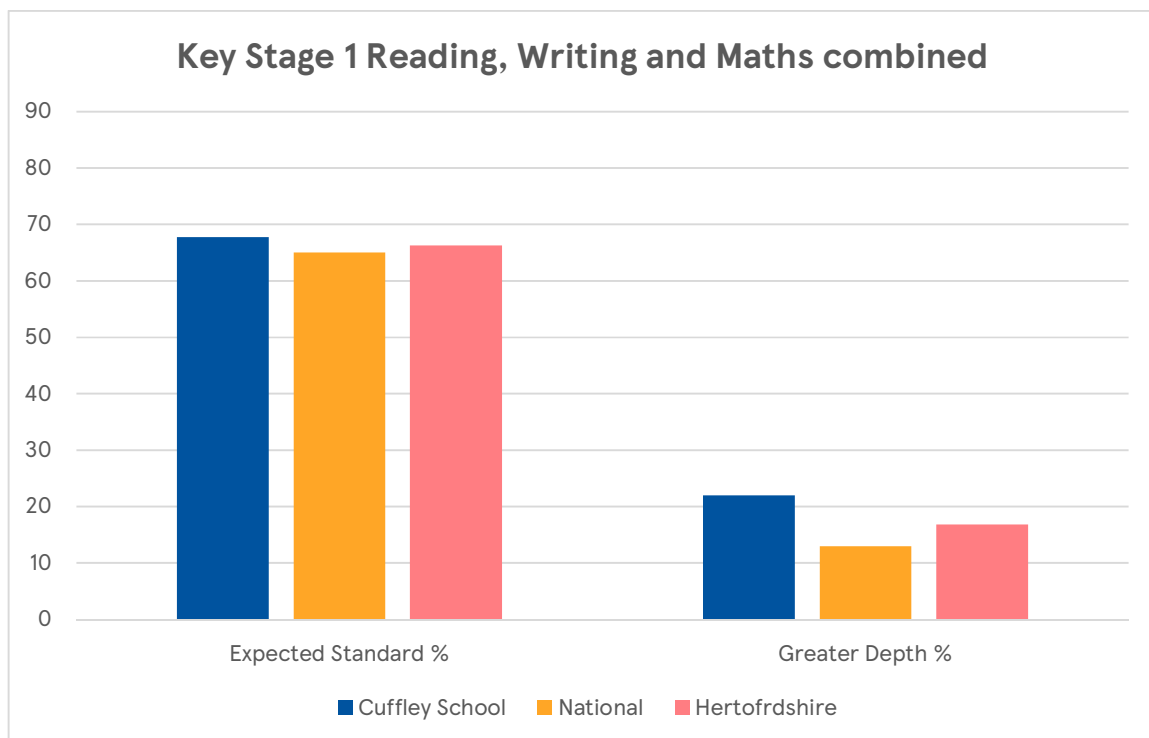
The percentage of children who achieved EXS and GDS in Maths at KS1 at Cuffley is broadly in line with pupils across the county.



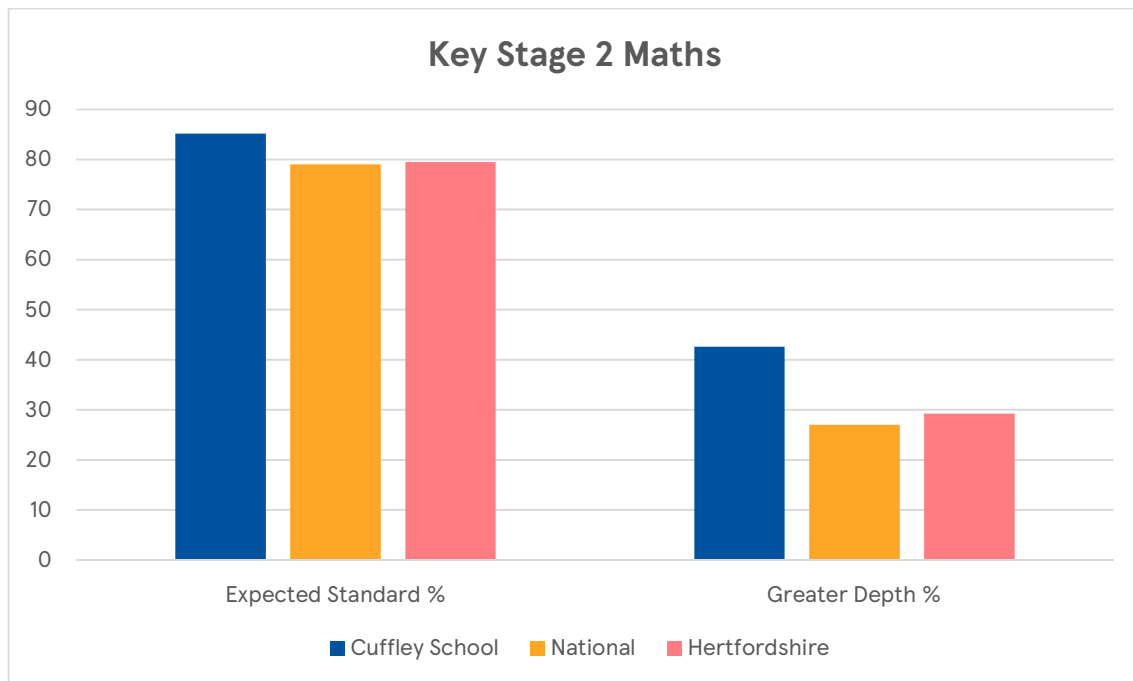
In reading at KS1, the percentage of pupils who achieved EXS is broadly in line with others nationally while those who achieved GDS is significantly higher than both the national picture and Hertfordshire's.



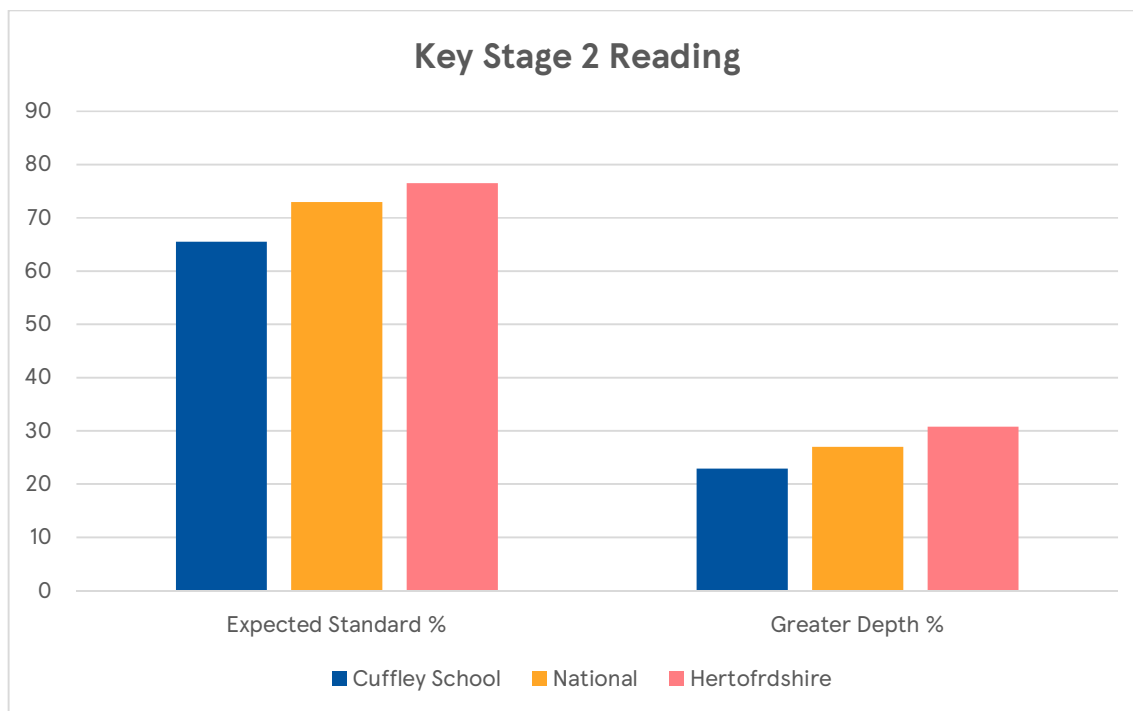
The percentage of children who achieved EXS in writing is in line with others in the county and across the country, while those who achieved GDS is higher than those across both.



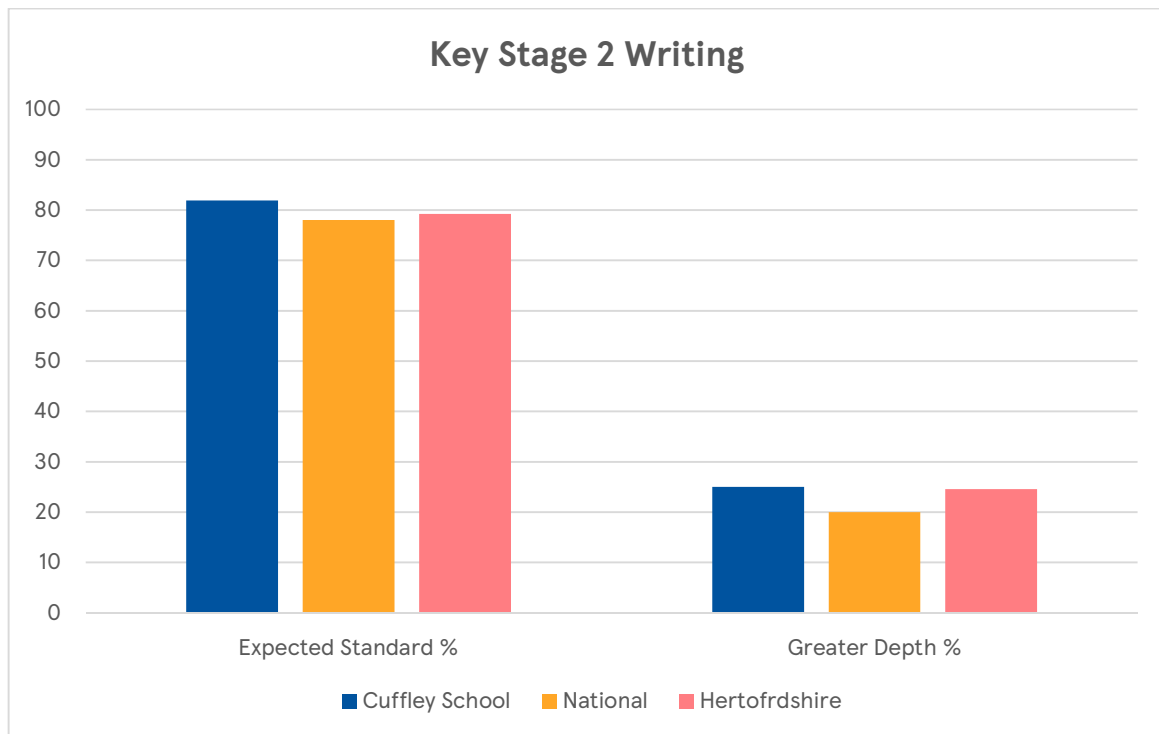
The percentage of pupils who achieved EXS and GDS in all three subjects is slightly above the national and Hertfordshire average.



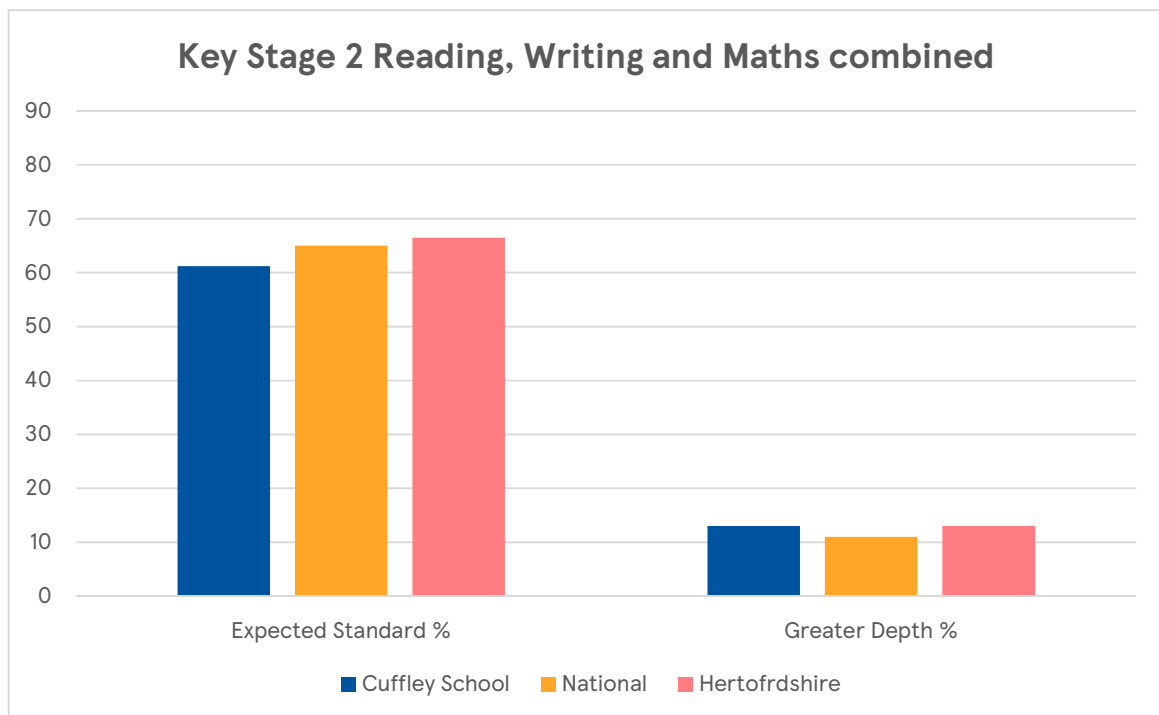
Key Stage 2 Maths Attainment this year is significantly above Hertfordshire and National at both standards.



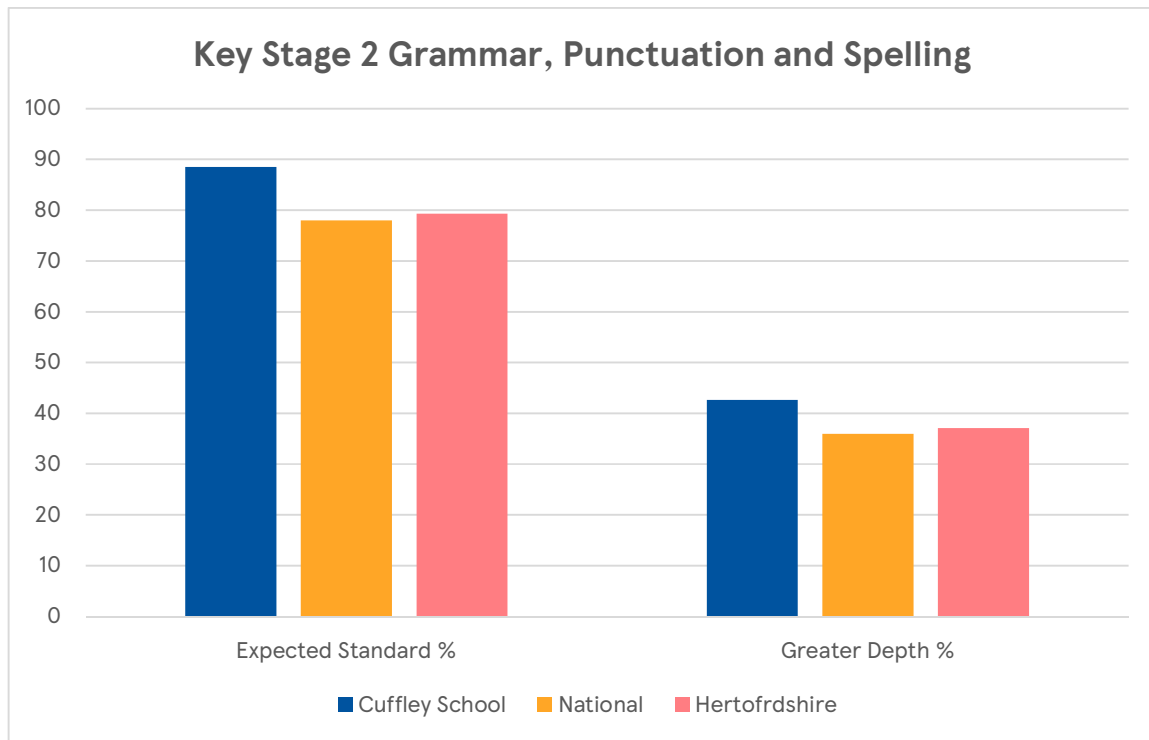
This year, attainment in Reading at Cuffley School was below both National and Hertfordshire. Compared to previous year's results at Cuffley this is also significantly lower. This can be partly explained by the lower KS1 starting points meaning that across their time in KS2, this cohort of children made more progress than both their National and Hertfordshire peers.



Cuffley School attainment in Key Stage 2 writing was slightly above National and Hertfordshire at both standards in 2019.



The percentage of children who achieved the Expected Standard in Reading, Writing and Maths is slightly lower than the national and Hertfordshire average, but this is solely explained by the significant drop in attainment in reading which is explained above.



Attainment of children at Cuffley School in GPS has continued to be significantly above the national and Hertfordshire averages.
