## Online Safety

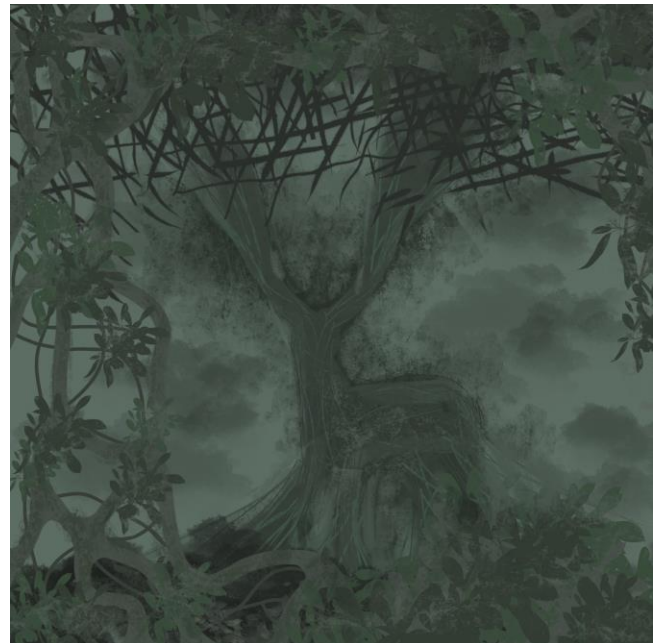
